**Welcome Rev. Chris Torrey**

Chris Torrey is a life-long Presbyterian. His father's family were missionaries in China; his mother's father was superintendent of an orphanage in Xenia, Ohio. After the College of Wooster, Chris was director of the Presbyterian Church Camp for New England, then went to seminary in Boston (Andover Newton) and Edinburgh, Scotland (New College, University of Edinburgh). He did Doctor of Ministry work at Princeton Theological Seminary. After youth ministry in Boston and Detroit, Chris served 12 years as pastor and Head of Staff in San Jose, California, and at Lakeside Presbyterian Church in Northern Kentucky, from which he retired in 2017 after 22 years. Chris and Dawn were married three years ago and moved to New Richmond, Ohio, where they enjoy a great river view, 13 acres of peaceful property, and a community in transition. Dawn and Chris each have two children; Chris has two grandchildren.


